OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

Front Range Alliance Church is committed to providing a safe environment for all children participating in church activities.

- All FRAC Staff are screened with character references and a criminal background check.
- All children & youth ministry volunteers are screened with character references and a criminal background check.
- Children's Ministry volunteers will check-in each child & ensure that each child is only
 picked up from class by the parent or guardian who checked-in the child or by a teen
 family member approved by the parent or guardian.
- The FRAC Life Safety Team is discreetly present on Sunday mornings monitoring activities in the building.

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU

Parents ~ For the safety & security of your children and everyone in the FRAC Building, please make your children aware of these building policies. Parents are responsible to communicate and uphold these policies.

- 1. No running inside the building.
- Parents must check-in and pick-up children from the nursery and the Pre-K/K and 1st-3rd Grade Sunday School classes (4th-6th Grade students may go to class and be dismissed without a parent).
- When children are checked into the nursery or a Sunday School class the teachers & helpers have eyes on them. Otherwise, parents are responsible to have eyes on their own children.
- 4. When the 2nd FLOOR CLOSED signs are hanging on the stairs, children must stay on the first floor.
- 5. The basement is off limits to all children.
- 6. Children must be accompanied by a parent in the kitchen.
- 7. The stage & sound booth in the sanctuary are off limits to all children unless participating in a formal FRAC event on stage.
- 8. Please accompany your children in the parking lot.
- 9. Take note that all of the entrances into the building (front door, west doors, office door) are locked about fifteen minutes into the worship service (approx. 10:30am).
